You can now complete Part 1 of the pension application online!

Thinking about applying for your pension benefit? The American Federation of Musicians and Employers' Pension Fund (AFM-EPF) has improved how you apply for your pension benefit. You can now complete Part 1 of the pension application online. Using the online process is easier, faster, and helps reduce common mistakes. Here's how to get started:
